



Participation in any auction on the Hodgins Halls Auction Group bidding website (the "Site") is subject to the Auction Terms and Conditions. Hodgins Halls Auction Group (Hodgins Art Auctions Ltd. and/or Hall's Auction Services Ltd.), the "Auctioneer," reserves the right to periodically modify the Terms and Conditions and it is your responsibility to review any changes prior to each use of the Site. By using the Site, you agree in advance to accept any such changes.

- 1. To participate in any auction, you are required to register on our Site. All registration information you provide shall be current, complete, and accurate. Bidders must be 18 years of age or older. You will be suspended or permanently banned from the Site if you provide false information when registering, such as a false name, fraudulent contact information, or a stolen credit card.
- 2. The Auctioneer reserves the right to pause, suspend, delay, or restart any auction in the event of internet outage.
- 3. Auction purchases are subject to a 20% Buyer's Premium on the bid price.
- 4. Although the Auctioneer takes great care and diligence in the cataloguing of lots offered for auction, all property is sold "as is".

All parties bidding at the sale shall be held to have informed themselves as to the condition, identity, and authenticity of lots, and are not entitled to make any objections after the sale on any grounds whatsoever. All items are sold on an as-is-where-is basis and no guarantee is given as to their condition or suitability for any purpose.

The Auctioneer does not include condition notes in the description of the lots. Please use the photographs as a guide to condition. If you have any questions or concerns, the Auctioneer will provide condition reports upon request.

Bidders can inspect auction lots in person during the scheduled preview times. Take this opportunity to determine the condition, size and whether any item may have been repaired or restored. By placing a bid online, you agree that you have either inspected the respective lot or have waived your right to do so.

- 5. All items offered for auction are subject to a start price which the Auctioneer will not sell below.
- 6. The auctioneer reserves the right to refuse admission to the sale, to refuse to approve the registration of any online bidder, or to refuse to recognize any or all bids from any particular person or persons at any auction. If the auctioneer decides that any opening bid is below the value of the lot offered, he may reject the same and withdraw the lot from sale, and if, having acknowledged an opening bid, he decides that any advance thereafter is insufficient, he may reject the advance.
- 7. The highest bid accepted at the lot closing will be the winning bid. The close of a successfully bid lot signifies the acceptance of a contract with the Auctioneer, selling as agent for the consignor.
- 8. The security of your account username and password is your sole responsibility, and you are responsible for any bids placed under your bidding account.

- 8. Online auctions begin and end at a predetermined date and time. If an item receives a bid during the final two minutes of the count-down clock there will be an automatic bidding extension: the bidding clock will be extended by two minutes for that item alone. The time extensions continue until there is a two-minute period during which no bidding takes place on the lot.
- 9. Credit card transactions may be limited to \$5,000.

- 10. If the purchaser fails to pay for any lot within seven (7) days from the date of the auction sale, the Auctioneer may, without limitation of the rights of the Auctioneer against the buyer, resell any of the articles affected and in such case the original buyer shall be responsible to the Auctioneer for; (a) any deficiency in price between the re-sale amount and the amount to have been paid by the original buyer; (b) any reasonable charge by the Auctioneer for the storage of such articles until payment and removal by the subsequent buyer; (c) the amount of commission to which the Auctioneer would have earned had payment been made in full by the original buyer.

Maud Lewis began painting under the instruction and encouragement of her mother, initially selling Christmas cards door-to-door for 5 cents apiece. From modest beginnings, Lewis initially used modest and found materials. She became known for her bright, joyful and nostalgic folk scenes of Nova Scotia life. Her renown grew following a CBC "Telescope" broadcast in 1965. Numerous important commissions followed, and more commercial success, which allowed her to expand her use of artistic material to include the use of oil paint, and commercial masonite panel (as in this piece). Today, Maud Lewis is Canada's most recognized folk artist.

Ltd.), the first of many. He soon moved to Winnipeg to accept the position of Principal at the Winnipeg School of Art. Upon his return to Toronto, to teach at the Ontario College of Art, in 1927, he formally and amicably ended his association with the Group of Seven. Johnston preferred independence, choosing to follow his own path and ideology. The artist maintained an interest in teaching, founding his own art school in Georgian Bay, which operated during the summers from 1930-1940. Franz Johnston was a versatile artist, influential educator, and active exhibitor during his career, achieving considerable commercial success during his lifetime.





Note: Lismer visited the Georgian Bay region for the first time in 1913, staying at the residence of art patron Dr. James MacCullum at Go Home Bay. The location so impressed him, that he returned numerous times during his career, both with his family and with numerous sketching partners. Lismer described Georgian Bay as a "paradise for painters". Thousands of islands, rocky outcroppings, and wind-swept pines, dramatically and harmoniously juxtaposed against a tranquil sky and labyrinth of bays and inlets, provided much artistic material for the artist and inspired an impressive body of work. While Georgian Bay was a favoured subject matter of Lismer, the use of aluminum panel in this painting is rare. 

Note: During his long and prolific career, A. Y. Jackson travelled more widely than any other member of the Group of Seven. Over almost seven decades he painted every corner of the country, even the most remote, documenting the Canadian landscape. In essence, Jackson was a plein air painter and was compelled to continually travel and sketch, often in areas close to home, and often in the company of friends and fellow artists. Later in his career, Jackson frequently painted in the Upper Ottawa and Madawaska Valleys, a region that was comprised of both rugged terrain and rural farming country (depicted in this work). Jackson continued to paint until 1968, when incapacitated by a stroke. He spent his final years as an artist-in-residence at the McMichael Gallery (now the McMichael Canadian Art Collection Art Gallery) in Kleinburg, where he is buried.

Note: Casson, the youngest member of the Group of Seven, was introduced to the original members at the Arts and Letters Club in 1920 by Franklin Carmichael. He soon became a regular at the Club and an invited contributor to the Group shows, though it was not until 1925 that he joined the Group on a trip to Lake Superior. He accepted the invitation to join the Group the following year. While an important member of the Group of Seven, Casson was always somewhat removed from the Group, and strove to set his work apart from that of other members. He travelled and sketched frequently, as he had a love of the outdoors and plein air painting. The artist's focus was progressively drawn to the gentler and more civilized areas of southern Ontario. He painted small towns, pastoral and rural scenes, at various times of day and throughout the seasons. Casson captured images, for posterity, of a landscape that he feared was quickly disappearing: "the pastoral pioneering Ontario that has vanished in the face of a noisier urban world."
